- In preparation for the upcoming Division Upskilling of Key Stage 3
 Teachers in Science: Addressing the Least Mastered Teaching
 Competencies, all Science teachers from Grades 3 to 10 are requested

 targeted upskilling seminars for Science teachers in School Year
 2025-2026.
