

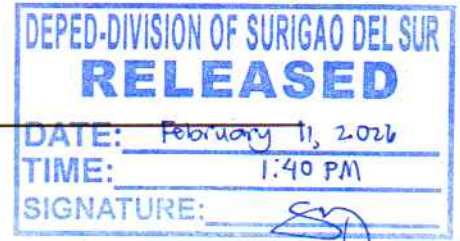

IMPLEMENTATION OF THE ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE (AI) -READY ASEAN TRAINING

1. The Office of the Assistant Secretary for Strategic Management (OASSM) of the Department of Education (DepEd) shall spearhead the pilot implementation of the National Training on Artificial Intelligence (AI) under **Project Accelerating Governance and Adaptive Pedagogy through Artificial Intelligence (AGAP.AI)**
2. Project AGAP.AI is a national program integrating AI literacy into the Philippine basic education that aims to train **1.05 million learners, 300,000 teachers, and 150,00 parents in 2026**, covering AI fundamentals, ethics, and practical, safe usage.
3. DepEd will roll out an ASEAN-funded AI training on AI literacy, combining school-based sessions with monitored self-paced learning with its Local Implementing Partners (LIPs).
4. In connection with this, an AI-Ready ASEAN Training will be conducted from December 2025 to May 2026 to select Junior and Senior High School Teachers, students, and parents, with devices and stable internet connectivity. Below is the breakdown of participants for the identified secondary schools.
5. School heads shall determine the participants for the said training and submit an endorsement. The templates for the endorsement may be downloaded here: **<https://tinyurl.com/SUR-HRDMatters> on or before February 13, 2026.**
6. Enclosed is the breakdown of the number of participants per school.
7.
