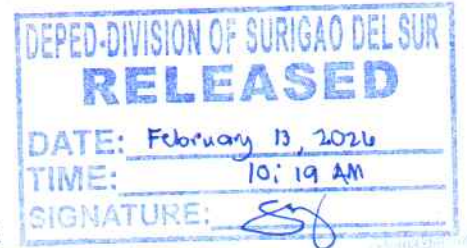

**CONSOLIDATED PROGRESS TRACKING AND PERFORMANCE EVALUATION ON  
 THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE KHAN ACADEMY PROGRAM**

1. In line with the Schools Division's commitment to data-driven instructional monitoring, this Office releases the Progress Tracking Report on the Khan Academy Program implementation. This report encapsulates school performance from January 5 to February 8, 2025, as extracted from the Division's real-time online monitoring dashboard

2. This evaluation serves to measure the consistency of platform utilization and the growth of learner proficiency in Mathematics. It highlights sustained successes, identifies recurring implementation bottlenecks, and mandates specific corrective measures for schools struggling to meet Division targets.

3. To ensure the program reaches its full potential, all 19 Khan Academy Implementing Schools are strictly directed to adhere to the following refined performance benchmarks:

**Skill Mastery:** Each class must complete **at least two (2) skills per week** via lessons and mastery activities.

**Platform Engagement:** Every learner must achieve a minimum of **30 learning minutes per week**.

**Active Participation:** Schools must maintain **100% weekly** active usage among all enrolled learners.

4. School Heads must analyze the Annex A Performance Data to identify school-specific gaps and immediately implement two (2) localized strategic interventions. For "Priority Schools" with low or zero engagement, heads must diagnose technical or readiness barriers and submit a formal findings report to the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) for immediate support.

A. Detailed Analysis

1. Carrascal NHS leads the division in student effort with 334 learning minutes, while Hinatuan NHS shows the highest growth with 29 skills leveled up. This demonstrates that consistent time on the platform directly correlates with mastering more topics.
2. Davisol NHS is highly efficient, achieving 23 skills leveled up in only 100 minutes. Conversely, schools in the "Priority Group" like San Miguel NHS and Gamut NHS are only logging 17 minutes total, which is below the division target of 30 minutes per week.

3. Previously inactive schools like Lingig NHS and Barcelona NHS have successfully started their programs, with Barcelona NHS notably jumping to 85 learning minutes and 10 skills leveled up.

**B. Strategic Suggestions for Improvement**

1. To maintain momentum

- Let top-performing students assist classmates who are struggling with specific math skills.
- Assign "Course Mastery" goals to push students toward higher grade-level competencies.

2. To increase efficiency

- Teachers should check or monitor students with many minutes but few "Level Ups". This means they are trying but failing; they need a 5-minute one-on-one explanation.
- Require students to master at least 2 specific skills per week rather than just "browsing" the site.

3. To build habit

- Set a permanent 30-to-40-minute "Khan Academy Time" in the computer lab every week.
- Post a "Top 5 Minutes" or "Top 5 Skills" list in the classroom to motivate students.

4. To remove barriers

- School Heads must check if the low activity is caused by broken computers or slow internet and report it to the Division.
- School Heads should review the teacher's dashboard once a week to ensure classes are actually logging in.
