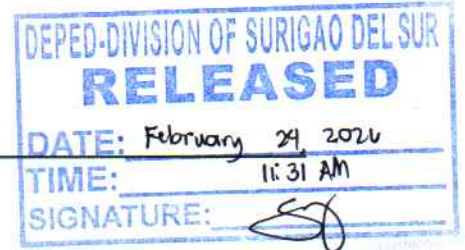

NATIONAL WOMEN'S MONTH 2026 CELEBRATION**

1. This Office informs the field of the DepEd – Schools Division of Surigao del Sur’s participation in the month-long celebration of the National Women’s Month 2026 from March 1-31, 2026.
2. This 2026 celebration aims to honor women’s contributions and strengthen advocacy on women’s empowerment and gender equality, anchored on the theme, marking the third installment of the 2023-2028 recurring theme: “WE for Gender Equality and an Inclusive Society.”
3. In line with PCW Memorandum Circular No. 2025-07, all governance levels are enjoined to undertake any or all the following activities:
 - a. Display the official NWMC Tarpaulin in office Facades.
 - b. Conduct capacity-building activities on gender mainstreaming, for DO and District GFPS
 - c. Use the All-Women Cast Lupang Hinirang Video in NWMC activities (download at <http://tinyurl.com/lupang-hinirang-all-women>).
 - d. Participate in #PurpleFridays or #PurpleyourIcon by wearing purple advocacy shirts every Friday of March and Decorating Offices or Landmarks in purple.
 - e. Support Musika ng Kababaihan (#MNK) by playing PCW advocacy songs in offices and on social media throughout March (accessible via <https://library.pcw.gov.ph/search/?q=musikjuana>).
 - f. Conduct women-led three growing activities under the government’s A Million Trees, including the Tree Growing Activity for DO personnel and District GAD Coordinators.
 - g. Participant in NWMC activities organized by partner agencies (LGUs, NGA, NGOs), stakeholders, and communities.

4. All DepEd personnel are encouraged to participate in and support the above activities. Official business may be granted and charged to GAA-GAD funds, local funds, or other allowable sources.
