- The Department of Education, Division of Surigao del Sur implements the School-Based Feeding Program with 211 elementary schools as beneficiaries in order to address the undernutrition problem among the learners, improve school attendance and to reduce dropout rates in schools.
- 2. School Nurses are required to monitor the implementation of the program under DepEd Order No. 54, s. 2013, section IX, Program Monitoring and Evaluation, letter C. Monitoring and Evaluation No. 2. TWG is expected to monitor compliance of the schools to the guidelines, procurement process, health and nutritional assessment and the conduct of complementary activities such as deworming, food production, waste management, handwashing, tootbrushing activity, good grooming, personal hygiene and productivity, life and values development training.
- 3. School Nurses with SBFP schools will report to the SDO every now and then thus the need to have a communication allowance for monitoring and reporting purposes.
