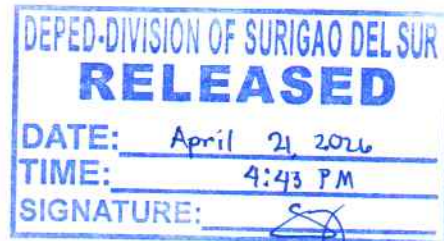

**HOSTING OF THE REGIONAL TRAINING FOR TEACHERS ON THE REVISED  
ALTERNATIVE LEARNING SYSTEM (ALS) CURRICULUM**

1. The National Training of Trainers (NTOT) on the Revised Alternative Learning System (ALS) Curriculum is a strategic initiative to establish a cadre of master trainers tasked with cascading the updated curriculum across the Philippines. This program addresses the critical need for consistent, high-quality implementation of the revised ALS curriculum, emphasizing strengthened foundational skills, values formation, and the integration of 21st-century competencies for out-of-school youth and adult learners. By equipping trainers with expertise in orientation, contextualization, facilitation, and mentoring, the NTOT aligns with the Department of Education's (DepEd) Five-Point Agenda, fostering inclusive, accessible, and future-ready learning opportunities for marginalized learners.
2. To ensure the effective nationwide rollout of the Revised ALS Curriculum, cascading training to the regional level is essential. The NTOT capacitates a select group of master trainers to interpret and deliver the curriculum with fidelity. However, to reach all ALS implementers, including teachers across every division, regional cascades are necessary. These regional training program ensures that all ALS teachers regionwide are equipped with the knowledge, skills, and resources to implement the curriculum effectively, maintaining consistency and quality while addressing diverse local contexts effective School Year 2026-2027.
3. The regional cascade process enables localized adaptation of the curriculum, fosters peer mentoring, and ensures quality assurance, aligning with DepEd's commitment to equitable and inclusive education. This approach is guided by official issuances such as DepEd Order No. 13, s. 2019 ("Policy Guidelines on the Implementation of the Enhanced ALS 2.0 Curriculum") and relevant DepEd Memoranda, which mandate regional offices to lead professional development initiatives for ALS teachers and monitor curriculum implementation. These directives underscore the responsibility of regional offices to sustain support

for ALS delivery, validate contextualized learning materials, and provide ongoing technical assistance to divisions.

4. By building a robust regional corps of trainers, facilitators, and mentors, the cascade ensures that every division meets DepEd's standards for the Revised ALS Curriculum. This strategic approach bridges national directives with local realities, ensuring that curriculum reforms benefit all learners, particularly those in marginalized communities, and contribute to the broader goals of education reform and inclusive learning.
5. Fortunately, the Division of Surigao del Sur is chosen to be the venue of the of the above-cited professional development activity. Hence, the hosting of the Regional Training for Teachers on the Revised Alternative Learning System (ALS) Curriculum in Tandag City, Surigao del Sur. Schedule and exact venue is to be announced through a separate memorandum.
6. Participants of the activity are all the Regional ALS Focal Person, Division ALS Focal Persons, Education Program Specialists in ALS, all ALS Teachers, Learning Facilitators and members of the Program Management Team. Below is the breakdown of number of expected participants by division:

7. For Surigao del Sur Division, participants including the members of the Program Management Team are enlisted in the annex of this memorandum.
8. Participants shall be given Service Credits/ Compensatory Overtime Credits as per DepEd Order No. 26, s.2025 , authorized grant of credits to teachers and non-teaching personnel for work beyond regular functions or beyond regular work hours/days where payment of honorarium or overtime pay is not possible.
9. Expenses incurred for meals, snacks and accommodation of participants including the LED wall rentals, advocacy shirts, materials and supplies shall be taken from SUB-ARO RO-13-25-01711 ( 1,402.00) and SUB-ARO RO-13-25-01712 (2,000,000.00) downloaded to Surigao del Sur Division subject to the usual budgeting, accounting, and auditing rules and regulations.
10. Travelling expenses of ALS teachers shall be charged to SEF/local funds while those of from schools shall charged their travelling expenses from their School MOOE/local funds. Travelling expenses of division personnel shall be taken from ALS Program Support Funds/Division MOOE. All are subject for the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
