**Subject: Summer Reading Camp 2019 &
Summer Reading Camp Pre-Service Coursework**

1. The Library Hub Team in the Office of Learning Resource and Management Development Section of this division will conduct Summer Reading Camp – Season 3 with a theme “Let’s Read to be Ready” on April 15, 2019 up to May 25, 2019 and Summer Reading Camp Pre-Service Coursework on April 11-13, 2019.
2. The Summer Reading Camp 2019 is an activity designed to provide pupils reading and writing opportunities especially those who were significantly marked as non-reader or in frustration level during the conduct of the recent OPLAN PABASA.
3. Kindergarten pupils who will be approaching grade 1 for the S.Y 2019-2020 will be also accommodated in this program.
4. This is a Six-week activity, with a minimum of four days of instruction per week and five hours of instruction per day. The activity will be implemented through monetary compensation of qualified camp instructors who will be hired from among the teachers of their particular district. The pupils identified to be part of the camp are expected to attend regularly on engaging instructional and hands-on learning experiences.
5. The purpose of the reading camp is to provide pupils who are significantly below reading proficiency passing level and fail to demonstrate reading fitness with the opportunity to receive quality, intensive instructional services and support at no cost to the parent or guardian.

- o. The reading camp will be held at the following venues: Carrascal Central Elementary School (CCES), Adlay Community Elementary School (ACES), Dahican Elementary School (DES), Bon-ot Elementary School (BES).

7. The aforementioned schools are required to complete the template attached and shall be submitted on or before April 3, 2019.

9. Summer Reading Camp 2019 and Summer Reading Camp Pre-Service Coursework is a partnership program of the Division Library Hub and the Clarence T. Pimentel – Construction and Mining Corporation (CTPCMC) of Kaayungan Adlay, Carrascal, Surigao del Sur.

10. There is no registration fee to be collected, and all interested parents of Carrascal I and II Districts can send and register their children for this reading tutorial program.

11. Attached is the result of the recent conducted OPLAN PABASA.

12. The number of remarked non-readers and frustration level of the District I and II of Carrascal as shown in the table will be given priority to register in the Camp.

13. School Heads of the said schools shall prepare at least 4-6 rooms for the conduct of reading tutorial session starting on April 15, 2019 up to May 25, 2019.
