 - a. The teachers listed in the Travel Authority attached to this memorandum will conduct weekly learning sessions focused on Science, aiming to enhance learners' higher-order thinking skills and improve learning outcomes in preparation for international learning assessments.
 - b. The inclusive dates for these sessions are **March 5, 12, 19, and 26, 2025.**
 - c. The **fund source** for this initiative will be **Division MOOE and/or the Program Support Fund (PSF).**
 - d. Learning facilitators (LFs) scheduled for the succeeding weeks shall follow the same implementation process to ensure continuity and sustainability of the initiative.
 - e. Teachers conducting these sessions are required to **submit their lesson plans using the 4A's instructional model** (Activity, Analysis, Abstraction, Application).
 - f. Learning facilitators must collaborate with their assigned partner LF to develop lessons that will also be useful for their **4th Quarter**
