

SUBJECT: **OPLAN KALUSUGAN SA DEPED ONE HEALTH WEEK**

DATE: July 18, 2019

1. Pursuant to DepEd Memorandum No. 083, s. 2019, all public schools are encouraged to observe a division wide **Oplan Kalusugan sa DepEd One Health Week** from July 22 – 26, 2019.
2. One Health Week will be conducted to roll out a set of health activities featuring, but not limited to, the six major DepEd school health programs below:
 - a. School-Based Feeding Program (SBFP);
 - b. National Drug Education Program (NDEP);
 - c. Adolescent Reproductive Health (ARH) Program;
 - d. Water, Sanitation and Hygiene (WASH) in Schools (WinS) Program
 - e. Medical, Nursing and Dental Services; and
 - f. School Mental Health Program.
3. During the One Health Week, all elementary and secondary schools are directed to undertake the following suggested activities, among others:
 - a. Orientation of parents, communities, partners, and other stakeholders;
 - b. Delivery of age-appropriate health services;
 - c. Launching of age-appropriate health and hygiene practices;
 - d. Conduct of feeding activities and school gardening activities;
 - e. Exhibits/fora on the NDEP, ARH, school mental health, and comprehensive tobacco control; and
 - f. Open house of canteens featuring healthy food beverage choices.
4. One Health Week shall be maximized to mobilize the community and promote collaboration with partners and stakeholders, especially at the school level. As such, the schools are tasked to network with partners within their localities for various health endeavors such as the improvement and maintenance of health facilities; provision of health and nutrition services including manpower, medicines and equipment; and finalization of deliverables and schedule of joint health activities for the school year.

5. For reporting purposes, the schools shall ensure the documentation of the activities conducted during the One Health Week, following the data requirements of the OK sa DepEd Forms A and B enclosed to DO 28, s. 2018
