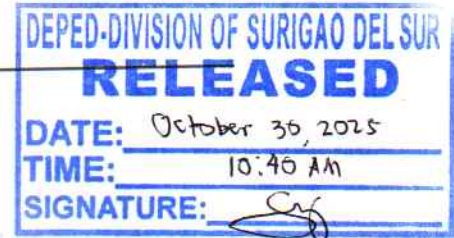

TAMBAYAYONG 2025: STAKEHOLDERS' CONVERGENCE AND RECOGNITION

1. TAMBAYAYONG 2025, an event organized to honor and celebrate the indispensable role of stakeholders in education, is anchored on the provisions of the 1987 Philippine Constitution, Republic Act No. 9155 (Governance of Basic Education Act of 2001), Republic Act No. 8525 (Adopt-A-School Act of 1998), and Republic Act No. 10533 (Enhanced Basic Education Act of 2013). These laws collectively highlight the vital participation of education stakeholders in promoting and ensuring equitable access to quality basic education. Likewise, various DepEd Orders on School-Based Management and Partnership Engagement institutionalize stakeholder participation and recognition as integral components in strengthening the efficiency, effectiveness, and responsiveness of basic education service delivery.
