CONDUCT OF ACTIVITIES FOR THE NATIONAL DAY FOR YOUTH IN CLIMATE ACTION

- 1. In support of the National Day for Youth in Climate Action observed every 25th of November each year, all Schools Division Offices (thru the DRRM, Youth Formation programs/Partnership) are enjoined to conduct, facilitate or lead activities to be participated by the SDO/school personnel/learners and/or partners.
- 2. The activities may be strategically conducted onsite or online provided it will not hamper the ongoing classes of the schools. Some climate-related activities may include growing trees, promoting renewable energy, practicing urban gardening, utilizing rainwater, walking, biking or carpooling, leaving no trace when travelling, contributing to and sharing eco-data, promoting environmental and energy consciousness, refusing single use plastic and consume responsibly.
- SDOs and schools may opt for other activities not mentioned above as may be deemed most relevant or appropriate for their personnel and learners to participate or engage in.
- SDO DRRM Coordinators shall submit a narrative report of the activities conducted in the SDOs/schools along with photos/videos, attendance sheets, and other relevant documents.
- 5. Expenses incurred for the activities conducted by SDOs shall be charged against their local funds (DRRM/Youth/Partnership) subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Attached herewith is the RDRRMC MC No. 63, s. 2022, for reference.
