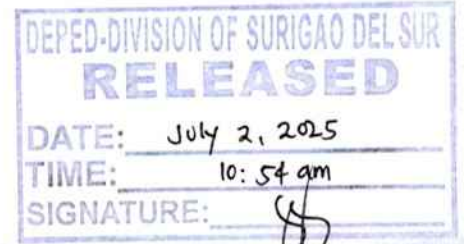

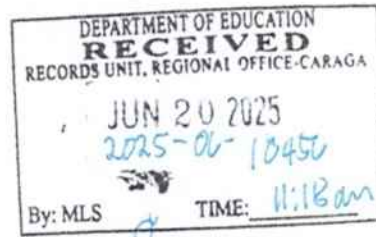

- Applicants must return to the Philippines immediately upon completion of fellowship

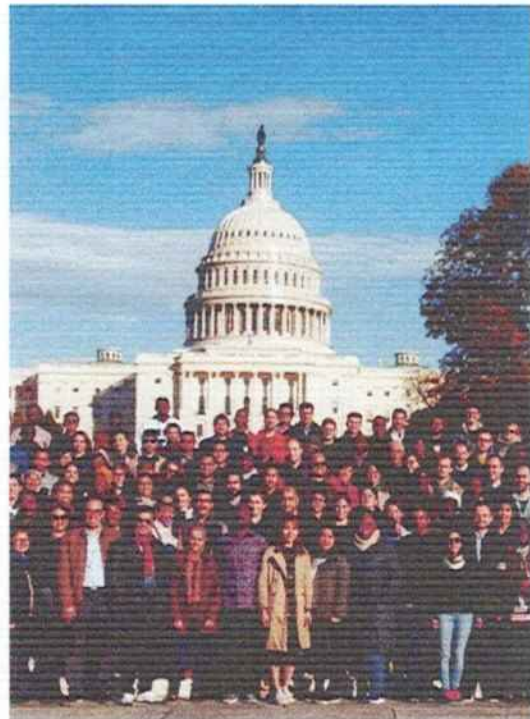
