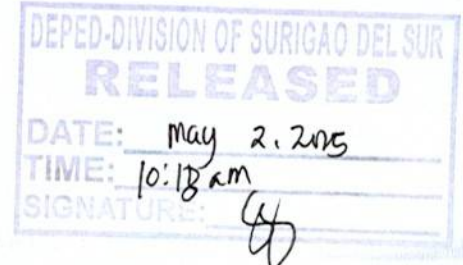



**DIVISION ORIENTATION ON DEPED ORDER 3, S. 2025 OR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF QUALITY-ASSURED ASSESSMENT FOR THE NATIONAL CERTIFICATION OF LEARNERS IN THE SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL TECHNICAL-VOCATIONAL-LIVELIHOOD TRACK AND EXPANSION OF THE NUMBER OF COMPETENCY ASSESSORS AND THE STRENGTHENED SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL PROGRAM**

1. The Department of Education (DepEd) has issued the enclosed Guidelines on the Implementation of the Quality-Assured Assessment for the National Certification of Learners in the Senior High School Technical-Vocational Education (SHS-TVL) Track. This initiative also includes the expansion of the number of competency assessors. These guidelines are in accordance with the relevant provisions of Republic Act No. (RA) 11975, which is part of the General Appropriation Act (GAA) for Fiscal Year (FY) 2024, and RA 12116, which pertains to the GAA for FY 2025.
2. In line with these guidelines, the Curriculum Implementation Division will conduct a Division Orientation on DepEd Order 3, S. 2025. This orientation will focus on the Implementation of Quality-Assured Assessment for the National Certification of Learners in the SHS-TVL Track, as well as the Strengthened Senior High School Program. The event is scheduled for May 29-30, 2025, at a venue that will be communicated later.
3. The expected participants for this orientation include Senior High School (SHS) school heads, SHS or Technical-Vocational Livelihood (TVL) coordinators, as well as the Public Schools District Supervisors (PSDS) and District In-Charge Supervisors (DICS) from this division.
4. Meals and snacks, along with travel expenses, per diem, and accommodation for teachers and school heads from the non-Implementing Units, will be charged against the school's 2025 Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses (MOOE) for the second quarter. In contrast, all expenses for participants from the Implementing Units will be covered by their own school funds. Furthermore, expenses for division personnel and PSDS will be covered by the Division MOOE, in accordance with

standard accounting and auditing rules and regulations. It is also underscored that participants from the districts of Cortes to Cagwait are not entitled for the accommodation.

5. All participating teachers will be granted Service Credits in accordance with DepEd Order 013, s. 2024, which outlines the Revised Guidelines on the Grant of Vacation Service Credits for Teachers.
6. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
